#### Linton District Schools Sports Association 2025 Athletics Sports (LDSSA)

Last week, the 2025 LDSSA Annual General Meeting and February general meeting were held at Woady Yaloak Primary School. This meeting was attended by representatives from the four schools (Woady Yaloak Primary School, Napoleons Primary School, Cape Clear Primary School, and Linton Primary School) that comprise the district.

Following extensive discussion, the committee decided to change the venue for our annual athletics carnival from the Linton Recreation Reserve to Llanberris Athletics Reserve in Ballarat. This will take effect starting this year. The confirmed date for the sports at Llanberris is Thursday, May 22nd.

This decision was not made lightly and followed reflection and discussions that have been taking place over the last 12 months. The LDSSA committee acknowledges that the athletics sports have been an institution at the Linton reserve for many years and wants to assure our communities that although the venue will change, the same family-friendly and inclusive environment will continue at the new location.

Some of the factors leading to the venue change include:

- The extensive amount of time required to mark lines, shift sand, and transport equipment from schools.
- Due to the extensive watering system at Linton, cars (which transport equipment) are no longer allowed to drive on the oval.
- · Sand (required for the long jump) can no longer be placed on the oval.
- Volunteer shortages In recent years, the LDSSA has struggled to secure volunteers the day before, the morning of, and after the sports to set up, maintain, pack up, and transport equipment.
- Experience The committee was keen to offer all students the opportunity to participate and compete on a 'track.'

The committee wants to reinforce that all events typically held will continue, with the option of adding extra events for some students that were not previously available (e.g., javelin). Families will still be able to cheer on our little athletes, and students will be able to continue to cheer their teams on from the school areas.

As part of our start of the year program we again welcome all families in for a shared afternoon tea on Monday, 24th February.


#### **Active Schools Grant (Bike track)**
