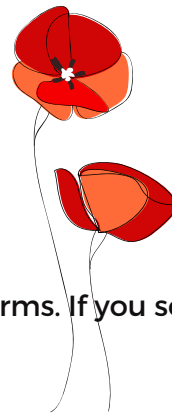

Learning Snapshot

F - 2	<p>In maths, we have been learning about different addition and subtraction strategies.</p> <p>In writing, we are exploring information reports</p> <p>In reading, we are doing an Author study on Julia Donaldson. We have been busy predicting what we will think will happen in the stories before we read</p>
3 - 6	<p>We are reading the novel Wonder by R.J. Palacio about a young boy who is 10 years old, has a facial abnormality and is starting school for the first time. We discuss each chapter as we go and try to put ourselves in the shoes of the main character Auggie.</p> <p>In Writing we are looking at the structure of Information Reports and are currently writing reports about an animal with information about their appearance, habitat, diet, predators and origin.</p> <p>Our numeracy focus has been addition and subtraction. We have been looking at adding and subtracting fractions and 2- 3 digit numbers. We will be doing a fun addition investigation challenge at the end of the week.</p>

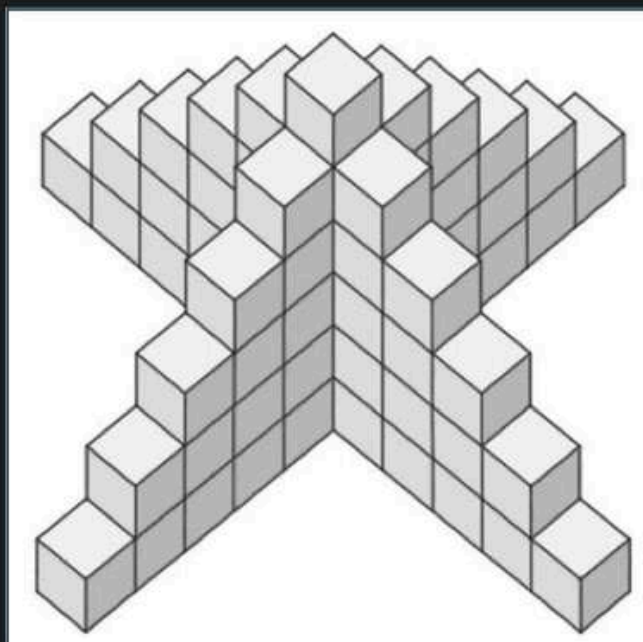

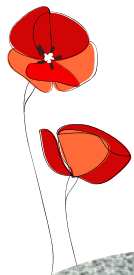
