Learning Snapshot

F - 2	Junior students have begun learning to count money, building on our skip counting by 2s, 5s and 10s skills. In writing we have learnt a variety of ways to use commas in our writing and have been going back and editing work to add them in where we think they should go.
3 - 6	Reading: We have been focusing on questioning - asking ourselves questions before, during and after reading Kids News Articles and our independent reading books. Writing: We have been focusing on punctuation and editing our work for capital letters, full stops, commas, talking marks, exclamation marks, question marks and apostrophes. Numeracy: We have been learning about fractions. We have learnt to add fractions and find equivalent fractions. We are now learning all about money!

- where it might eat

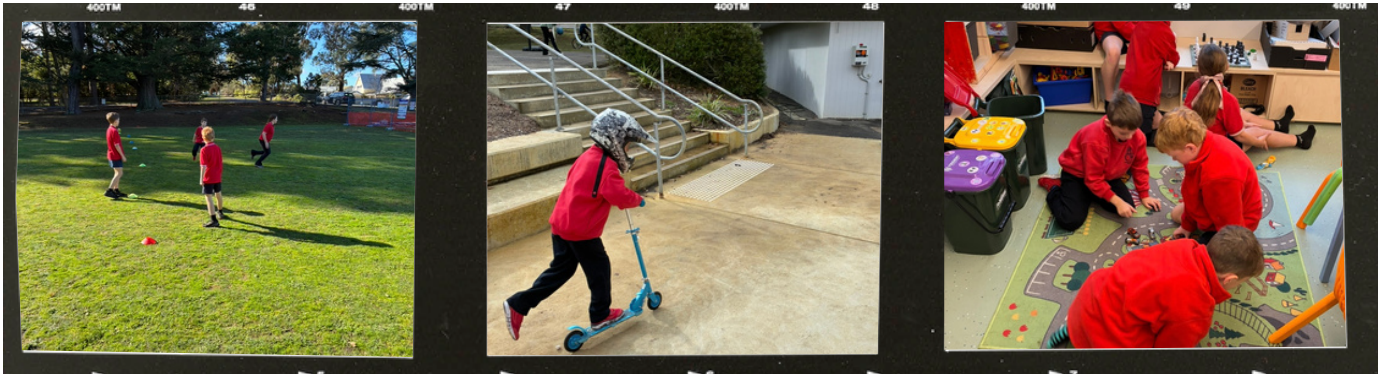
First Nations Peoples can use footprints to track an animal foot hunting or when looking after Country!
