LDSSA- 2026 LDSSA ATHLETICS

DAY INFORMATION

Permission notes have been distributed via Compass for our Athletics Day on Tuesday February 17th.

We are excited to again host the day at Ballarat Llanberris Athletics Reserve (11 York Street, Golden Point).

- The cost for each student is \$7 to cover hire costs and purchases to make the day successful. This is a change from previous years.
- Students will be required to be dropped off and picked up from Llanberris. Drop off can occur from 8:50am with an estimated finish time of no later than 3:00pm.
- With possible warm conditions, hats, water bottles and sunscreen is highly recommended for all participants and attendees. If there is bad weather (thunder/high rainfall/unsafe temperatures) and there is a need for cancellation – Principals will communicate with their school communities on the day prior.
- A canteen will be operated by the local athletics club. There will be a lunch break scheduled for each age group as part of the program.
- Communities from Cape Clear, Linton and Napoleons will set up school tents on the infield this year along with the Woody Yaloak campuses. This will allow visitors and families to use the stand areas for undercover seating.
- The program will this year start with a 1500m invitational running event. The first event commences at 9:20 a.m. The additional length event has been added with winners progressing to division sports at this distance.
- Timing gates have been hired to record times for all running and will assist with starting events.
- There will be no high jump events held on the day due to no ability to have four high jumps operational. Each school and campus will conduct their high jump events back at their campuses during Term 1. The school based events will be for students of all age groups.
- The event program is being finalised and will be made available prior to the day.
- Parent/carers assistance is once again required to make our day successful. Marshalls will request parent/carers help with events. We will ask that special consideration is made to not cross the running track and ensure access to the recording station remains clear.
- No dogs are permitted inside the track area at any time.
- Parents/carers are kindly asked not to park outside the designated parking spaces at the athletics reserve to support our traffic management controls. Street parking is available around the venue.
