Keeley - she liked doing it and it was fun to put the hands on the wings.

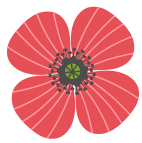
Callum - he felt good and liked building the rib cage.

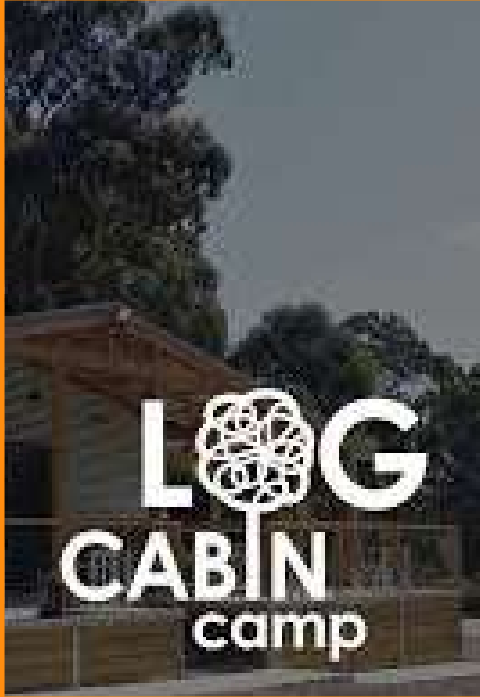
