Students have been practising their socialising and team bonding skills to play a range of outdoor activities during recess.

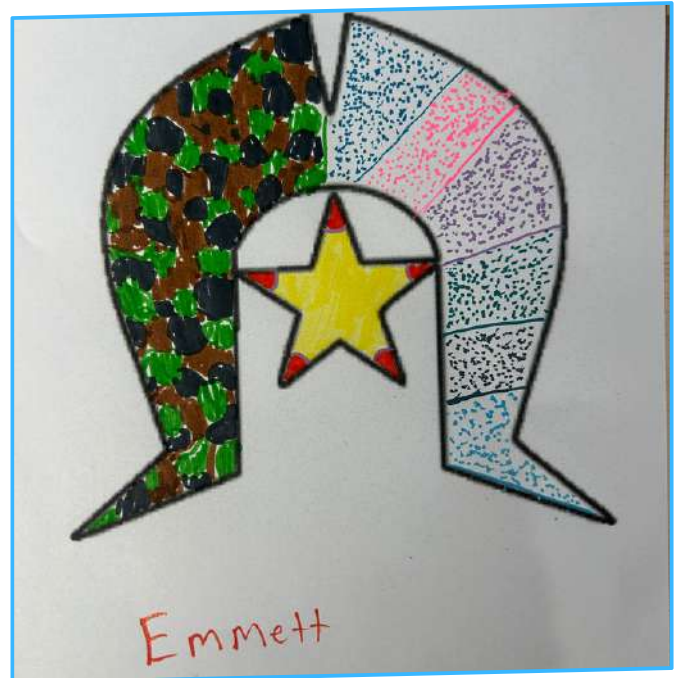
