Learning Snapshot

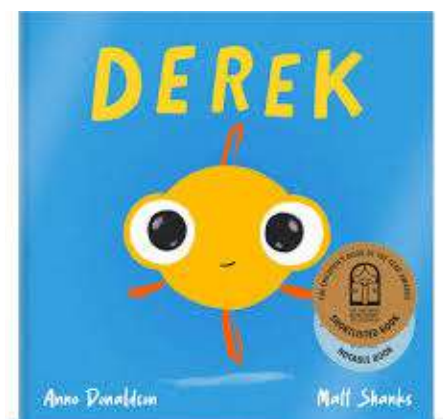
