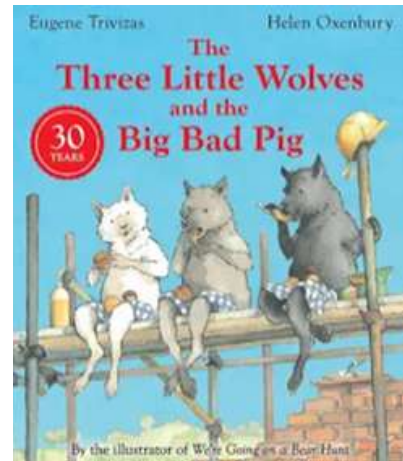

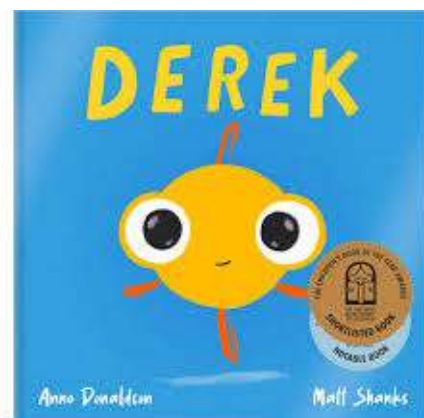
Learning Snapshot
