I appreciate our parents for catering for us at the Tabloid Sports and again this Friday at our end of term celebration.

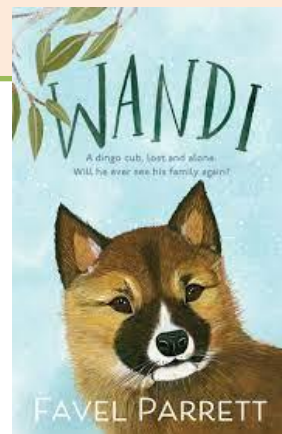
