Problem Solving Strategies

Make a table <small>4 legs 2 legs no legs cat dog snake</small>	Make a list <small>4 dogs 3 cats 1 rabbit</small>
Draw a picture/diagram 	Act it out
Make a model 	Identify a pattern 5, 10, 15, 20
Write a number sentence $3 \times 4 = 12$	Solve a simpler, related problem $100, 100, 100$ 2, 4, 6, 8, 10.
Guess and Check 	Work backwards
