LDSSA ATHLETICS DAY

On Wednesday, 20th March our LDSSA sports day will be held at the **Smythesdale Recreation Reserve oval**.

The program for the day will be running similar to previous years. All students from foundation to year 6 will be competing in a sprint, long jump, high jump, hurdles, shot put, discus and a relay.

There is also an opportunity for 9-12 year old students to run a distance of 800m.

We strongly encourage all families to stay for the duration of the entire day but if you leave early, you must notify the teacher.


We are going to add a Resilience Project section to our Newsletter.

A reminder that weekly assembly will be held on Friday at 3.15pm. It is a chance to share and celebrate learning and wellbeing from the week.


This Friday we will be having a Year 6 jumper and leadership presentation. It would be great to see as many families as possible to support our students!




Maths Game or Idea of the Week!
